Description of the scope of services

The carrier should provide transportation services to include all labor, material and administrative support consisting of the following:

Schedule maintenance Cost: The carrier shall keep the vehicles in good and safe operating condition and shall bear all costs associated in provision of fuel, security measures, lubrications and consumables items.
