Since 2000, USAID has **invested** more than **\$300 million** for hundreds of water and wastewater projects in the West Bank and Gaza.

USAID-funded wells produce

USAID has **connected** nearly **130,000 Palestinians** to **running water** in their homes for the first time.



USAID has established a **monitoring system** which tracks water flow and production rates to facilitate water management and distribution.
